Much like Vine has done, <u>Bloop It</u> is aiming to shorten videos into twenty second or less increments. Even better is that is allows you to cut YouTube videos down and share them across social networks easily. This means you can take the best twenty seconds of your three minute YouTube video and share it with your networks, ensuring amplified views thanks to the video's brevity.

#### SocialRadar

<u>SocialRadar</u> combines your location data with your social media networks, including Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Foursquare and a host of others, providing a snapshot of your connections and their locations. This allows you to head in one direction or the other to either interact with – or avoid – those who fall into your social networks.

# **Google Play Movies & TV**

As of January 2014, Google has opened up its <u>Google Play Movies & TV</u> app to the iOS community, which allows users to stream existing content. However, you will not be able to make purchases from your iOS device. The App Store will allow no such synergy. But it is nice to have access to items that you did not purchase through the Apple name, and take them on the road with you.

### **Momondo Places**

Momondo Places is a travel tool that matches your travel style, giving your access to free city guides based on your personality, using hand-picked tips. What's more is that you can search the city you are in for restaurants, entertainment and hot spots based on your mood! Feeling like a quiet night with a pint in the corner of a pub? Tell the app your thoughts, and receive a list of recommendations. Feel like dancing the night away? Just say so to be pointed in the right direction. You can even view the guides offline, and enjoy GPS directions to help get you there.

### QuizUp

<u>QuizUp</u> allows you challenge friends – and complete strangers – to a game of general knowledge. There are hundreds of topics and nearly one quarter of a million questions that can keep a group of interested parties pitted against each other for months!

#### **Facebook**

<u>Facebook</u> itself is a social media platform that allows you to create a group of "friends" with whom you share information, pictures, videos and games. The creators of Facebook have finally stepped up their game and maximized their app's interface to work optimally with iOS devices. The app lets you browse photos in full screen at higher resolution, and it integrates with Facebook apps and games that have an iOS counterpart (FarmVille, Words With Friends, Candy Crush Saga and hundreds of other options.

# Find My iPhone

Apple's Find My iPhone app is designed for locating any lost iOS device. It now lets you locate iPhones, iPads, and iPods from your home computer, or another device where you can access the website. You can shut down your devices completely from a remote location if you believe it has fallen into the wrong hands and your personal information is in jeopardy, or simply pick up the signal to realize you left the device in your trunk, at work or at your favorite restaurant.

### **Google Maps**

Years ago, Apple devices came standard with <u>Google Maps</u> and the world was happy, directionally functional place. Then Apple switched to their mapping system, and the world was lost without their Google infrastructure. Now Google Maps are welcome back to your iOS device, but will never be the default option again, so you must download the app accordingly – and you should.

# **Dropbox**

<u>Dropbox</u> is mobile cloud storage that allows more than the iCloud capability of you accessing your information from any device. Dropbox allows others to place items into your "Dropbox" so that you can access them from anywhere, whether you are using your iPhone, iPad or a Kindle Fire. Access documents, photos, and videos from a heterogeneous mix of mobile devices and allow others to share their items along the way. It is perfect for business use, and can give you the freedom to keep on the move, while others finish their reports for your approval later.

# **Duolingo**

<u>Duolingo</u> provides an exceptional platform that delivers an innovation approach to learning a new language, including French, Spanish, Portuguese, German, Italian or even English. The app uses gaming techniques that allow you to complete levels and compete with friends while you learn. The lessons are easy to follow and even provide the opportunity to translate text in the language studied.

#### **Burner**

Welcome to the world of anonymity called <u>Burner</u>. The app provides users with a temporary – and disposable – phone number, so you can make calls under the cloak of confidentiality. A burner number allows you to make outgoing calls, as well as accept incoming calls, texts and voicemails with a free number for seven days. This is the perfect tool to test the dating waters, looking into job searches or answering Craigslist ads.

#### Uber

The <u>Uber</u> App allows you to hire a private driver in over 50 cities and 20 countries around the world. Simply request a ride, compare rates for the different types of vehicles offered and get a fare quote in seconds. Payments can be made using PayPal or credit card, so you never have to pay the driver in cash. This app keeps you from standing in cab queues or taking a ride that develops into a small investment simply because you never thought to ask how much from a downtown city to its airport.

#### Shazam

If you have ever been riding along in your car, sitting in a restaurant or even shopping in a retail store and would like to know the name of the tune playing, simply tap on your <a href="Shazam">Shazam</a> app and allow it to analyze the song's digital fingerprint to reveal the name of the song, the artist, the album title and even the lyrics in a matter of seconds.

# eBay

The trusted way to buy and sell items in a familiar auction format comes to life on your iPhone or iPad with the <u>eBay</u> app. You take a picture of the item you want to sell directly from your device, upload it through the app and let the bidding begin with just a few keystrokes. You can also bid on items, track their current price in real time and solidify your purchase and make a payment all from the app.

# Skype

People who use iOS devices, including the iPhone, iPod and iPad, usually rely on Apple's FaceTime to keep in touch with those they love. <a href="Skype">Skype</a>, however, is incredibly handy because it lets you talk face to face – for business or pleasure – with those who do NOT have an Apple device. Believe it or not, these people exist and if you want to chat with them you are going to need an app that will allow you to do so effectively. Skype is that app.

### **Photo Editor**

The built in iOS Camera app has limited editing functionality built in, so adding an app that will help you edit your beloved images is a must for any picture posting perfection. Photo Editor provides filters, one touch enhancements (like red eye removal) and tools for retouching and drawing. That means you can remove blemishes, convert images to black and white or even paint color back into the image. You can also add text, should the picture not speak for itself.

# **Fotopedia**

<u>Fotopedia</u> allows you to travel the world by following other peoples stories that culminate from text and images of differing cultures, locations, wildlife and much more. It resembles a magazine format combined with a scrapbook, photo journal and travel guide all in one app. You, too, can create your own stories for others to follow, broadening someone else's reach in the world.

#### **TED**

TED: Technology, Entertainment, Design. <u>TED</u> is an app that provides talks from clever, intelligent and exceptional industry leaders around the world. You can watch TED talks live or download and view them offline. You can watch riveting content that enlightens you on technology, philanthropy and even inspirational content that is provided by the definitive guidelines you provide. The app will deliver selections that fit your needs and interests, while allowing you to broaden your knowledge on innumerable levels.

### **BBC** iPlayer

BBC provides an unbiased and professional look at news stories and content from around the world, and allows you to play that information in a video catch-up version that other news providers cannot come close to. You can download the content for later, or stream it over a wireless network. You can also watch it on your television screen by airing it over Apple's AirPlay option directly from your iOS device.

#### **Twitter**

<u>Twitter</u> is a social media platform that allows you to express your opinions to the world – or at least your connections that are called "followers" – in 140 characters or less. You can upload pictures, videos and even text that delivers a succinct

summation of what is going on in your world. Followers can favorite your comments, respond to them or retweet them as they see fit to spread the word.

### Remote

With the Remote App you can control your Apple TV using your iOS device. This is a great tool for those who want to search – as your keyboard definitely comes into play – and you do not have to type onscreen using the left, right, select, left, right, select functionality that the limited (and tiny) Apple TV remote provides. The app can also control local iTunes libraries and send the audio onto the screen via AirPlay.

# **Skyview**

If you have ever looked up to the sky and thought, "What is that? A planet? A star? The Space Station?" <a href="SkyView">SkyView</a> is the perfect app for you. Simply download it, engage it and point your device up to the heavens and receiving all of the information you could ever want about the stars, planets and space objects in real time. You can also jump forward and check the sky on upcoming dates and times, if you were inclined.

# **Great Paid iOS Apps**

Sometimes you cannot always get what you want out of a free app, and expect a little more from the paid version. Even if you are simply trying to get rid of overbearing advertisements and figure it is worth a couple bucks to use a clean version of an app, paying for some of the great ones is never a loss.

#### Horizon

The <u>Horizon</u> App allows you to shoot horizontal videos regardless of how you hold your device. That's right! No more waffling between shootings of landscape and horizontal, simply because you tipped your phone in the wrong direction while recording. It shoots the best format first, and maintains it at all times, for a mere \$1.99.

#### The Wonders of Life

Optimized for both iPhones and iPads, <u>The Wonders of Life</u> series brings you over 30 3D creatures and habitats, hours of HD live video streaming, over 1000 images of nature and all of her beauty, in tune with an awesome soundtrack, all for \$5.99.

#### **OmniFocus**

OmniFocus is an advanced task management app that uses location reminders, which can be handy for when you are in the exact area of a certain task on your list. For instance, if you have "pick up the dry cleaning" on your to do list, OmniFocus will remind you that you are going to drive right past your cleaners' location so that you can duck in quickly and complete a task without forgetting. It also offers maps and forecasts, as well as an enhanced task editor to help keep your life on track. Price: \$40

### **Jump Desktop**

Jump Desktop is an incredibly handy app for remotely controlling a Mac or Windows PC from an iPad or iPhone. The technology allows users to connect to an existing RDP (remote desktop protocol) or VNC (virtual network computing) server effortlessly. The Jump Desktop is the perfect way to control a work computer or off-location laptop from your mobile device for \$14.99.

### GoodReader

<u>GoodReader</u> allows you to open documents, images and even books, movies and maps in a PDF format, so your device can read anything sent its way effortlessly, all for \$4.99.

# Instapaper

<u>Instapaper</u> provides its app users with the opportunity to save articles for future reading, without having to look them up again – or remembering that you wanted to follow up on the content. Simply drag the Instapaper bookmarklet to your toolbar, and it will save all of your content until you are ready to read it.

# LogMeIn

Another remote control log-in app that is incredibly helpful and easy to set up, called <u>LogMeIn</u>, lets you use your <u>iPad</u> or iPhone to remotely control a Mac or Windows PC via WiFi or 3G cellular. You can purchase three months of the service for \$5.99, or a complete year for \$9.99. The Pro edition lets you transfer and save files among devices, access files stored on popular cloud services, stream HD video and sound, and print remotely to an AirPrint-compatible printer, which is a key feature if you are often on the road.

# **Sleep Cycle Alarm Clock**

This innovative <u>Sleep Cycle Alarm Clock</u> app assessing your sleeping condition by analyzing your resting hours, and wakes you up during your lightest slumber to provide a natural awakening, instead of a jarring alert. What's more is that with its iCloud support, your creations, changes, documents and content stay up to date across all of your iOS devices! You can import forms, contracts, worksheets, documents, presentations, and even books, while using the same note taking tools that are readily available to market up the items as you see fit – including PDF files. Even when you receive documents in Word or PowerPoint, Notability will import them flawlessly so you can read each document without any trouble. All of this is available for \$2.99.

### **iMovie**

Creating movies from the footage you record on your iPhone or iPad has never been easier, and we're not talking just replaying video footage. With <a href="Movie">iMovie</a> you can take your recorded footage, choose themes and clips you want to use to create a trailer – even adding a soundtrack, if you choose while creating special effects. The app allows you to tap and swipe to edit video, so the platform is exceptionally easy to use. You can fast-forward, replay in slow motion or even tap your favorite moments to refer to them quickly. # **Tweetbot**

Tweetbot is available on iPhone for \$1.99 and iPad for \$2.99

#### 1Password

<u>1Password</u> works exactly as the name suggests: 1Password to reach all of your pertinent information like bank accounts, credit card statements and secure login accounts across the web. The security protection is second to none, and you can reach all of your sensitive online profiles without compromising the integrity of your favorite password. Cost: \$9.99.

#### Reeder 2

RSS Feeds are incredibly popular, and Reeder 2 allows you to view all of your favorites from one, easy to read platform. Reeder 2 syncs with Feedly, Feedbin, Feed Wrangler, Readability and Fever so all of your news is readily available in a single place. You can also add feeds manually, and share or export content to compatible sharing services for \$4.99.

#### Moves

Sometime it may seem as if you walked 87 miles in a single day, while you run errands around the city. Moves allows you to verify your activity by tracking walking, running and cycling activity passively. The app will track your movements, exercises and calories burned as well as map out your route, so you can literally reflect on how you "ran around in circles" all day. The app is only \$2.99 and provides an array of information regarding your movement, so you can feel accomplished at the end of each day.

# FlightTrack 5

FlightTrack 5 is a necessity for anyone who travels regular, or who hosts guests that need a ride from the airport. With all of the modern technology available, it is still impossible for someone to tell you via in-air flight that they are delayed. With FligtTrack 5 you receive real time departure information, delays and even gate numbers for each flight you plug in. You can also receive alerts or push notifications for flights that are plugged into the app. You can even add upcoming flights to your calendar and allow the app to keep you posted on any delays for only \$4.99.

### TurboScan

<u>TurboScan</u> turns your iPhone into a multipage scanner for documents, receipts, notes, whiteboards, and other text, allowing you to keep the documentation electronically – and relieve the worry of losing a record.
